Topic:	MongoDB and Mongoose

Overview

In this lab, you will add database functionality to the previous lab.

Instructions

The base files include a `package.json`, so you should only need to install the dependencies with `npm install`. The rest of the file's contents are essentially identical to those from the previous lab. You can use your JavaScript from the previous lab as a starting point. Using the in-class examples as a guide, you will modify this code so that it checks the database to see if the username exists.

Before you start your application, be sure to:

- Run `mongod` to start the database itself
- Using the MongoDB client `mongo`, create a few sample users
 - Username: string
 - Password: string

The application will work exactly the same way as the previous lab, only now it will compare usernames against those found in the database.

How to Submit
